Objectives

The two-day refresher course aims to:-

- Identify measures that will assist the practical implementation of responsibilities established by new legislation, and new working practices.
- It aims to bring health & safety knowledge up to date, as well as giving a through overview of legislative changes and their impacts in the workplace.

Who for

Directors, managers and supervisors who have attended the five-day Site Managers Safety Training Scheme course since 01 January 2001, and whose certificate is due to expire (5 years). Delegates should be able to provide proof of previous attendance on a full five-day course.

Course Content

- Induction to health & safety management.
- Updated Health & Safety.
- Welfare & environmental legislation.
- Control of hazards and risks
- Responsibilities of Supervisors and Managers

Training Method

A highly participative course, with case study exercises for House Building, Civil Engineering, Factories & Ancillary Buildings, Demolitions, Refurbishment and New Roads & Streetworks.

Delivery is via power point presentation enhanced with video.
